Post Project Phase: Responsibility

Get to Know Them: Demographics of problem Awareness of positive and negative concerns regarding Issues

1. Identifying Consequences of problems - demographics of community and potential strengths

2. Considering conceptual, empirical, and practical options

3. Community collaborative decision making about what program to use

4. Implementing pilot program monitoring, correcting Start larger scale program evaluating, outcomes assessment

5. Exiting: plan in place for the future - credit to power sources - historical credit
