## **Security Journal Article Assignment**

### Assignment #2 (Class Presentation) Learning Outcome:

Read a security journal article and present a summary (~5 minutes) of what you learned to the class, relating it to course content.

#### Assignment:

Read a security journal article on a topic of your choice. Please refer to a scholarly or trade journal (no "popular" magazines).

Summarize to the class what you've learned in the article and how it relates to what we have discussed in this course.

To support your summary/class presentation, create several PowerPoint slides and upload them to Blackboard prior to the assignment due date.

To upload your slides to Blackboard, click on "Discussions" and then "Security Article Presentation." Review the instructions and then select the "Create Thread" link to attach your slides. Title the thread with your last name and title of your presentation (Example: Smith – Electronic Access Control).

The maximum number of points available for this assignment is 100. Please review the grading rubric on page two.

#### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this assignment is to test your ability to identify, research, and appropriately present one key security concept to the class. Knowledge of key security concepts are important to understand:

- 1. Key historical developments in security.
- 2. Differences between security and law enforcement roles.
- 3. Laws applicable to security issues.
- 4. Ways to prevent or reduce loss.
- 5. Techniques of inner/outer defense protection and access control.

#### **Criteria for Success:**

Your class presentation must be approximately 5 minutes and be supported by several PowerPoint slides.

This is what I expect:

- Follow the directions. Print out the instructions and check off items to make sure you have followed all necessary steps.
- Make sure what you present is understandable. Create effective PowerPoint slides.
- Relate how the material in the course is related to your chosen article. Make connections.
- Cite your resource material(s). The University Policy on Academic Integrity applies to all assignments.
