

### FCWR-161: ESSAY #1

For your first literary essay, write a 3-4 page essay on *one* (1) of the questions below.

- 1. In "Everyday Use," the title is connected to Mama's choice to give the quilts to Maggie who will put them in use, unlike Dee who would display them.
  - In a *three-four* (3-4) page essay, provide three reasons that explain Mama was right to give the quilts to Maggie rather than to Dee. Discuss each reason with specific examples, and support your ideas with many quotations from the text.
  - 1. In A Raisin in the Sun, Walter undergoes the biggest transformation in the play as his values change from the beginning to end.

In a *three-four* (3-4) page essay explain what Walter's ideas and feelings are about money, women, and family. Discuss each of these separately, and explain how his perspective changes over the course of the play. Provide specific examples, and support your argument with many quotations from the text.
