Discussion Board Rubric

Assignment Description: You will be required to respond to **2 proposed questions**. Your responses should be thoughtful and include a critical analysis of the topic thread. For each of your answers, you should also cite evidence to support your answer. References can come from existing course material; this can be lectures, the course texts, or other supporting literature. Any references included need to be cited in APA format, and the full citation needs to be listed at the end of your response. See page 3 for an example. **You will also need to reply to one fellow student response for each proposed question you've answered**. Replies to other student responses can include whether or not you agree with their submitted answer or questions that further engage in the topic based on the evidence they supplied. <u>All responses should be respectful</u>. Discussion board participation will be graded separately per question answered, and the grading expectations and full rubric is provided below.

Each discussion board assignment is worth 10 points total (5 points per question) and will contribute to the total class participation for the course.
